- 1. CALL TO ORDER & INTRODUCTIONS Matt Brown called the meeting to order at 6:02 PM
- 2. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S DRAFT MEETING MINUTES Frank Nelson makes a motion to accept the draft minutes, Philip Wattenbarger seconds, ayes have it.
- 3. UPDATES FROM STATE, MUNICIPAL, AND CHAMBER MEMBERS

Castleton: No updates, everything seems good.

Pawlet: No updates, amenities still being worked on. Parking lot has been full on weekends. **Poultney:** No updates.

Granville: N/A

Rupert: A few hurdles with parking area construction, currently on hold. VOREC grant has been extended to 6/30/25.

VTrans: Gates have been opened on northern end. Aiming to open southern end by next Monday (12/16) at the latest. In Castleton, VTrans will be adding signs to prevent folks from obstructing the gates by parking too close which would prevent emergency services from accessing the trail. New trailhead kiosk for Castleton is still on the docket. Jackie has been in contact with Town of Poultney about their Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant project looking at flood mitigation around the Poultney River bridge along the DHRT.

4. TRAIL FRIENDLY BUSINESS PROGRAM UPDATE (JACKIE CASSINO – VTRANS) Jackie presented on the VT Rail Trail Program's Trail Friendly Business Program. Philip inquired about adding a QR code on the trails to survey users, Jackie explained this is something they've done on other trails and will be rolling out to all the trails in the future.
